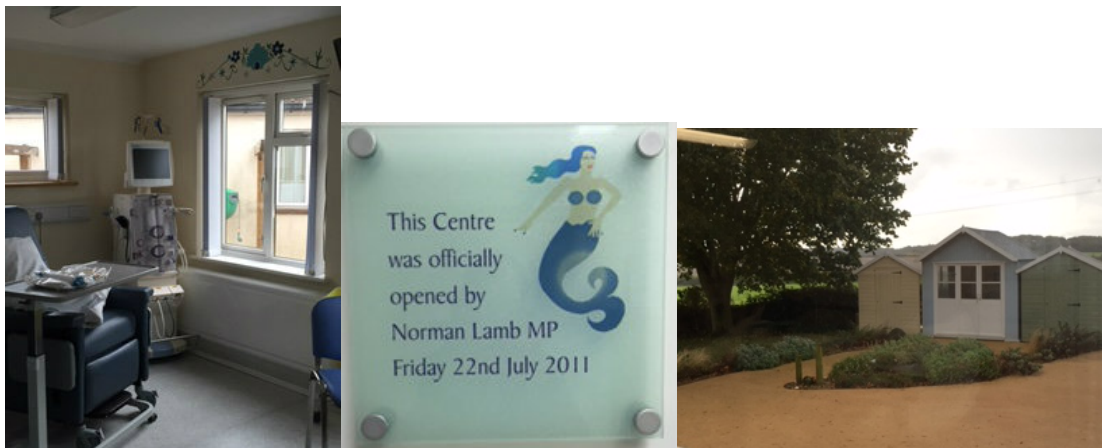


## Wells Community Hospital

The hospital offers a 4-bay kidney dialysis unit, with the latest equipment and very experienced staff. The Mermaid dialysis unit is open to local people and holiday visitors for dialysis away from base. It is an impressive unit, with excellent views into the well-kept garden area and fields beyond.



The hospital hosts the Town Council office, a dentist offering NHS care, and a range of clinics and community support clinics. The dementia service is particularly popular.

The hospital is tastefully furnished and equipped, and has a feel of being a much loved facility. And there is scope to do more within the building.

The charity is committed to returning NHS community beds to the area. We wish them well in this venture.

My overall impression was that of a light and airy building, a warm welcome, and the potential to provide even more services and facilities in this community-run hospital.
