Terms and Conditions

1 Payment Terms:

- Full payment is due within 30 days of receiving the invoice.
- Payment must be received prior to the event date.

2 Cancellation Policy:

- Cancellations made more than 60 days before the event will receive a full refund.
- Cancellations made between 30-60 days before the event will receive a 50% refund.
- No refunds will be issued for cancellations made less than 30 days before the event.

3 Exhibitor/Sponsor Responsibilities:

- Sponsors and exhibitors are responsible for their own travel and accommodation arrangements.
- Exhibitors must adhere to the setup and teardown times provided by the event organisers.
- All promotional materials must be approved by the event organisers prior to the event.

4 Liability:

- The CHA and event organisers are not responsible for any loss, damage, or injury that occurs during the event.
- Sponsors and exhibitors are responsible for their own insurance. This should include adequate Public Liability insurance.

5 Use of Logo and Branding:

- Sponsors grant the CHA permission to use their logo and branding for promotional purposes related to the conference.
- All logos and branding must be provided as described above. Failure to do so may result in omission from promotional materials.
