UPDATE FOR 2022:

6-space area to establish a Community SDEC (Same Day Emergency Care) 7-day service

Since February Bodmin have offered 24/7 admissions
Created lab testing on site that includes Point of Care Testing onsite
Links have been made with a specialist Adolescent unit on the
Bodmin site to provide enhanced care needs which is preventing
admissions to other hospitals
